Financial Aid Award Requirements

Financial Aid Award funds will only be applied to the tuition for the 2025-2026 academic school year. After the tuition deposits and registration fees have been paid, the award will be dispersed commensurate with your selected payment plan.

Tuition assistance does not cover the tuition deposit of \$500.00, the registration fee of \$600.00, the student retreat fee, or any additional fees which may arise from enrollment in specific classes and programs. These costs will be the parent's responsibility.

The criteria to maintain this award are as follows:

- To accept the award, the Student and Family must complete your **enrollment checklist** by the day specified in the award letter.
- St. Thomas promotes a community atmosphere. There is an expectation of active parental involvement, volunteerism, attendance at events, as well as support of the school's fundraisers and activities.
- The Student must maintain a good attendance and conduct record.
- The Student is required to attend the annual Scholarship Breakfast held each Spring.
- The Student is required to sell a minimum of one quota of raffle tickets for our annual fundraiser, the Round Up raffle, which supports the financial aid program.
- Tuition payments and all fees must be made promptly in accordance with the payment plan selected. Tuition assistance may be revoked for late payment.
- This award is solely for the 2025-2026 school year.
- **Renewal:** Each year, a new application is required to be considered for financial aid in subsequent school years.

Scholarship Award Requirements

Scholarship Award funds will only be applied to the tuition for the 2025-2026 academic school year. After the tuition deposits and registration fees have been paid, the award will be dispersed commensurate with your selected payment plan.

Scholarship Awards does not cover the tuition deposit of \$500.00, the Camp Aquinas fee of \$600.00 and the registration fee of \$600.00, or any additional fees which may arise from enrollment in specific classes and programs. These costs will be the parent's responsibility.

This scholarship is solely for the 2025-2026 school year. Your core cumulative GPA will be evaluated at the end of each Fall Semester to determine if you qualify to continue an academic scholarship listed below for another year.

The requirements to maintain an academic scholarship are as follows:

- 4.50-4.74 – Goodness Discipline & Knowledge Scholarship of \$3,000.00
- 4.75-4.99 – Aquinas Scholarship of \$5,000.00
- 5.0+ – Principal's Scholarship of \$7,000.00

Presidential and Academic Excellence Scholarships are one-year awards. Students who receive this scholarship will be eligible for the Principals, Aquinas, and Goodness, Discipline, and Knowledge scholarships after their freshman year. Basilian Father Scholarship and Gable Scholarship recipients should refer to their award letter for renewal requirements.
